## Producer Responsibility Obligations (Packaging and Packaging Waste) Regulations 2024

This report summarises Electro Mechanical Systems Limited’s position in relation to the Producer Responsibility Obligations (Packaging and Packaging Waste) Regulations 2024 and the UK extended producer responsibility regime for packaging.

Electro Mechanical Systems Limited is a UK-incorporated company and undertakes activities that may fall within the scope of the regulations as a packaging producer.

Electro Mechanical Systems Limited has an annual turnover exceeding £2 million. However, an assessment into the packaging material in 2025 identified that the company shipped 9.85645 tonnes of packaging, which is below the 25-tonne threshold for small-producer reporting obligations and below the 50-tonne threshold for large-producer obligations.

The information above has been calculated by comparing the total shipped weight of dispatches from Electro Mechanical Systems Limited against the actual product weight of parts sold. The difference has been treated as the estimated packaging weight for the purposes of this internal assessment.

The packaging weight reported includes packaging that is returnable and or reused, as well as pallets which have been purchased from recycled sources. As the reported packaging volume remains below the 25-tonne threshold, Electro Mechanical Systems Limited has not segregated this information further at this stage.

Based on the 2025 assessment, Electro Mechanical Systems Limited remains below the applicable packaging reporting thresholds. The company will continue to monitor packaging volumes annually and review its position if packaging use increases.

### Sustainability measures and ongoing improvements:

- Introduce returnable and reusable packaging where viable.
- Purchase packaging materials from organisations using sustainable sources.
- Reduce the use of plastic-based materials where practical.
- Promote mono-material packaging to improve recyclability.
- Reuse inbound pallets and purchase additional pallets from recycled sources.
