## Russia (Sanctions) (EU Exit) Regulation – UKSI 2019/855

The Russia (Sanctions) (EU Exit) Regulation came fully into force on 31 December 2020. This regulation is intended to ensure that certain sanctions relating to Russia continue to operate effectively, the Regulation imposes financial, trade, shipping and immigration sanctions for the purposes of encouraging Russia to cease actions which destabilise Ukraine, or undermine or threaten the territorial integrity, sovereignty or independence of Ukraine.

EMS has assessed our supply chain in relation to these products and can confirm, in accordance with the above Regulations, that our products do not originate from Russia nor are they made from raw materials that originate in Russia or have been subsequently processed in third countries into any of the specified products which are covered by the regulation prior to importation into the EU.

In line with the requirements of this regulation, EMS do not knowingly sell products to any customer who sells, exports or re-exports, directly or indirectly, to the Russian federation or for use in the Russian federation.
